**Procedure for Completion of Pre-Admissions Examination
(Baccalaureate Track)**

Admission to the Division of Nursing

Once a student is admitted to Grand View University, the student may apply to the Division of Nursing. A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 and completion of pre-requisite course work is required for admission to the nursing program. The applicant also must take the Elsevier/Evolve REACH A2 examination. This examination measures the applicant's achievement of critical academic skills and will assist in determining potential for success in the nursing program. The applicant must achieve 70% or greater on both the REACH A2 Reading Comprehension test and Basic Math Skills test.

Procedure for the Pre-Admission Examination

The Elsevier/Evolve REACH A2 examination is offered at multiple Prometric Test Centers across the United States. The applicant will register for the exam by email at exameligibility@elsevier.com. **You must specify the month you wish to test.** The applicant provides the following information to Elsevier Review and Testing:

A confirmation notice will be sent indicating that the applicant may register for the exam. Applicants are encouraged to register for the examination as soon as they receive their Eligibility IDs to ensure availability of their choice of testing center.

The applicant is responsible for verifying the accuracy of the information in the confirmation notice. If the information is incorrect or changed, the applicant needs to contact Elsevier Review and Testing by email at exameligibility@elsevier.com. The applicant will schedule an appointment for testing at <http://www.prometric.com/Elsevier>. The applicant will complete only the Reading Comprehension and Basic Math Skills tests on the REACH A2 Exam. Applicants may test only one time in each admission cycle.

The student's application, REACH A2 test scores for reading comprehension and basic math skills, and other admission documents must be received in the Division of Nursing by the application deadline. Applicants are advised to begin the process for examination registration at least two months in advance of the application deadline.
